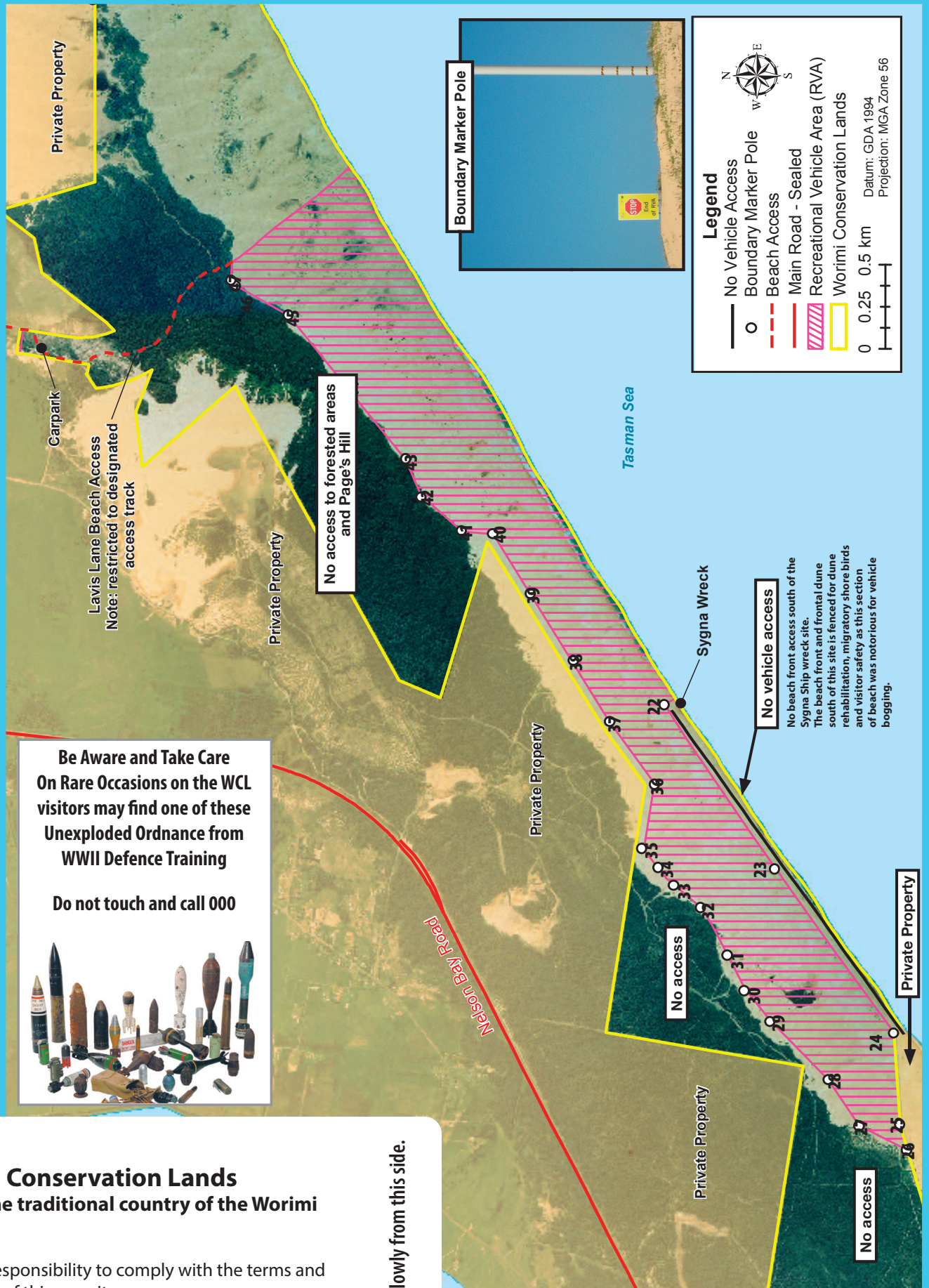
Be Safe...

HAZARDS WARNING

- Soft sand, bogging and inundation from high tides and seas
- Sudden drop offs
- Gutters in beach front
- Buried debris
- UXO's do not touch
- Storm surge
- Beach erosion
- Avoid sharp turns and sudden braking.

Warning:

Do not drive through water without checking its depth. Rain may cause water to pond on tracks, which can hide holes. Driving through water may be unsafe and could damage your vehicle.
